Migrating Oracle EBS to the Cloud

ACL uses Oracle E-Business Suite (EBS) 12.1.3 Financials, Purchasing, Inventory and Asset Management modules. EBS is a mission critical application for ACL and is used by employees across the US. Oracle EBS is integrated into several other applications within the organization and it is fundamental to many business processes.

ACL had been working with a third party hosting organization and they were running EBS in a hosted data center, with single tenant infrastructure.

So why did they want to change? Their hosting contract was coming to an end and they were looking for a cloud solution for their critical applications. Specific drivers for the move to the Amazon Web Services (AWS) Platform were:

- Flexibility (add or remove servers and storage as needed)
- Cost Reduction
- Pay As You Go (no upfront capex)

ACL decided to start work on AWS infrastructure with a development and test environment until they were comfortable with the platform and ready to go live. 
managing EBS including security, back up and DBA services.
