

# **Case Study:** Distribution Company Finds ROI in Improved Wi-Fi Coverage

Since 1939, Caffey Distributing has been supplying beer, serving 16 counties spanning the Charlotte, Greensboro and Winston-Salem area of North Carolina.

### Poor Wifi Coverage Limits Caffey's Productivity

Caffey Distributing has supplied beer since 1939, serving sixteen counties across North Carolina. Headquartered in Greensboro with 131,000 sq. feet of office and warehouse space, Caffey recently expanded into the Charlotte market under the name of Carolina Premium Beverage and will soon open a new location in Concord.

As Caffey's staff grew to more than 175 employees in its Greensboro location, the wireless network struggled to keep up. "Everyone could not get online at the same time," said Randy Irwin, Caffey's IT Administrator. "Company meetings were a struggle with everyone's devices. They were causing the network to slow down, which impacted second shift production."

A reliable wireless network is crucial to Caffey's success. The Wi-Fi in the warehouse needs to cover every square inch to support the accuracy of their order selectors. Errors in their picking process or inventory system are costly to their business.

For daily operations, Irwin knew they needed a network infrastructure capable of handling their needs now and in the future.

The reliable wireless network gives Caffey the tools it needs to implement new technology and grow revenue. "This has paved the way for other

software options, allowing us to save money in the long run," said Irwin. "Our accuracy rate will go up 1.2% by implementing new order selection software." Upgrades like this will not only make life easier for employees but will ultimately generate a return on Caffey's technology investment.



After experiencing success in the Greensboro location, Caffey now plans to implement the same solution in the other two sites. "We now have a scalable solution for all locations and it is easy to manage," said Irwin.
