The cloud and City Cloud key elements in the new strategy

As part of the new strategy, and as the Cloud Services area suggests, some of the security products will be offered as cloud services, with City Cloud as the base for delivery. Clavister Management and Analytics is already provided in the cloud and during the current year (2019) an additional three of the company's products will become available as cloud services.

Swedish roots with global reach form important part of customer offering

The choice of City Cloud as the cloud platform developed gradually and was ultimately a completely natural decision. City Network's origins and



roots in Sweden was one important aspect, and that the IT infrastructure service is available in the key markets in Europe where Clavister sees greatest growth potential. In particular the German market, where City Network has a City Cloud node in Frankfurt. Another important parameter was that City Network has used Clavister's products for many years as part of its data center infrastructure.

Launch of Clavister's first cloud service and more to follow

Once the decision to use City Cloud was made, Clavister began preparing its service for distribution as a cloud service on the City Cloud platform. This work lasted a few months and resulted in a few minor adjustments to adapt the service for cloud delivery.

"We have had an excellent collaboration with City Network and work progressed smoothly adapting our software for City Cloud, not least as City Cloud is based on OpenStack which facilitated the integration," says John Vestberg.

Several customers now use the control panel as a cloud service. Clavister's research and development department is working intensively to prepare additional services for delivery via City Cloud as there is great demand for these services from both private and public sector operations in Europe.

"Moving forward, I am convinced that all customers will use a mix of security solutions supplied both as installed software and as cloud services."
