ICT Support

What started as a requirement for basic onsite connectivity for exploration, rapidly grew to incorporate multiple solutions for one of the fastest growing gold mining operations in the Pilbara. The rapid expansion of infrastructure to facilitate the needs of many staff & contractors required deployment of multiple technologies at the different stages of De Grey's evolution. This included:

3G/4G Boosters - Supply and installation of Cel-Fi mobile boosters to assist with 3G calls and 4G data were implemented.

SD-WAN - SD-WAN solutions were supplied to bond Internet connections and also provided a failover in the event one type failed.

VOIP – A VOIP phone system allowed for internal calls to be routed to staff where mobile coverage was poor, but internet connectivity was available.

Microwave links to Telstra Fibre back haul - Qbit researched and advised De Grey management on the available options for more robust and permanent communications to site. This ultimately involved the supply and installation of Aerial towers to provide microwave links from the Telstra Fibre 20km's away from the site by a third party.

Extensive camp Wi-Fi Solution - A scalable wireless solution providing data, entertainment, and security camera coverage to all parts of the Administration and accommodation areas.
