CHALLENGE

Ivanhoe Grammar School is one of Melbourne's leading private schools. It offers Early Learning to Year 12 across 3 campuses, supporting over 2,800 students and staff.

The school's storage platform, consisting of two arrays, had been in place for four years, was reaching capacity, and was draining resources from a management perspective. The school wanted to refresh this storage environment with an affordable solution that would be easier to manage and could help them proactively update their systems to ensure maximum availability and performance.

LONG-TERM PARTNERSHIP

Ivanhoe Grammar School turned to their long-term IT partner, Novo3, for help in their infrastructure refresh project. As this was the third major HPE infrastructure upgrade Novo3 had completed at IGS, they were fully aware of the school's goals and how to design an infrastructure setup to meet their needs.

Novo3 undertook a comprehensive approach to design and implement the new infrastructure for Ivanhoe Grammar School. They began with the design and planning phase, creating a solution that included 8 HPE Proliant servers, 4 SANs, 8 Apollo tape libraries, and SAN switches, spread across 5 data centres on 3 campuses. Novo3 managed the entire project, providing all necessary technical resources and overseeing the deployment process. The deployment phase involved setting up the new infrastructure, migrating data, and ensuring minimal disruption to the school's operations. Thorough testing was conducted to ensure all systems functioned correctly and met performance and availability requirements. Novo3 also provided training for the school's IT staff on managing and supporting the new systems.
