Challenge

Flight Centre employs a range of technologies that enable digital workspace services for its employees and business partners. Central to these technology solutions has long been a deployment of Citrix technologies, with Flight Centre traditionally deploying and managing these themselves in-house.

Like many organisations in the travel industry, the COVID-19 global pandemic dramatically impacted Flight Centre and prompted the company to review all areas of its business for efficiencies, including its IT infrastructure.
